

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Melville Bridge Club encourages people with mobility issues to play at the club.

Our policy has been that for those people with a doctor's statement or a temporary disability, reserved seating can be provided.

This policy is designed to help players attend.

The Director of the day has the responsibility of organising the movement for the number of people present. This is why members are asked to attend at least 10 minutes prior to commencement of the event. It is a matter of being fair to the Director.

Please note that, once approved, Reserved seating is on a permanent basis without any need for reminders.

However, there have been several incidents lately where reserved seating has been provided as requested and the recipient has not attended and the Director has not been advised.

The Tournament Committee has taken the view that players **MUST** inform the Director if they are not attending at least 10 minutes before the due time. **Failure to do this more than once will result in removal of the privilege of a reserved seat.**

Regarding special events such as Club Championships, it should be noted that if the number of reserved seats requested exceeds the number of stationary positions available then there will be a ballot to allocate those seats. This is necessary as the Director must attempt to create an equitable movement. When possible, our Directors will endeavour to cater for all those members with mobility issues.
